

WINWOOD CATTLE ACHIEVING SOLID GAINS

Garry Walsh “Winwood” Monto has an eye for good cattle. Since purchasing his first Burenda bull 10 years ago he has sold brangus and brahman cross progeny through a number of weaner show sales with excellent results. Often achieving the top price on the day or occasionally winning a class or two. Around 200 brangus infused cows are now joined to Burenda angus bulls with thick long calves that grow the result. The angus bulls do take some adapting to the change in environment but the resulting calves make it all worthwhile.

Highlights for Sales

193.2 cents/kg for a pen of angus cross weaner steers at **Eidsvold Santa Show Sale 2013**. At 297kg they topped the sale price for steers on the day.

Eidsvold Weaner show sale Wednesday the 29th May 2014. Garry won the Champion Pen of heifers at the sale. An impressive 278kg then sold for \$1.35/kg on a very depressed market. The

steer portion made \$1.66/kg and weighed in at a healthy 319kg. Both these pens were Angus cross progeny by Burenda bulls out of brahman and brangus breeders.

Eidsvold All Breeds Weaner Show Sale Wednesday 11th June 2014. Garry Walsh from Winwood Eidsvold won the champion pen of 15 brangus cross steers weighing in at 285kg and selling for a healthy \$1.80/kg in a soft market. The steers were out of a brangus base herd of 200 cows that were running on open forest country grazing native pastures and were weaned into the yards off the cow. The progeny were by Burenda brangus and angus bulls he has purchased over the last 10 years.
